- 1/14** Martin Luther King Jr., “Letter from Birmingham Jail;” “I Have a Dream”  
〈從伯明罕監獄寄出的信〉；〈我有一個夢想〉  
--“Freedom is never voluntarily given by the oppressor; it must be demanded by the oppressed.” (自由從來都不是壓迫者心甘情願給你的；它必須由被壓迫者強力要求取得。)
- 2/4** James Weldon Johnson, *The Autobiography of an Ex-Coloured Man* 《某個去色人的自傳》  
-- "I believe it to be a fact that the colored people of this country know and understand the white people better than the white people know and understand them." (我相信這個事實，這個國家的有色人種對白人的瞭解和理解比白人對他們的瞭解和理解要多得多。)
- 2/18** James Baldwin, “Going to Meet the Man” 〈將去見那人〉  
--“I love America more than any other country in the world and, exactly for this reason, I insist on the right to criticize her perpetually.” (我愛美國甚於愛任何其他國家，正是因為這個原因，我堅持永遠可以批評她的權利。)
- 2/26** Peter Farrelly, *Dir. Green Book* (film) 《幸福綠皮書》  
--“So if I’m not black enough, and if I’m not white enough, and I’m not man enough, then tell me, Tony, what am I?” (所以如果我不夠黑，如果我不夠白，我不夠 man，那麼告訴我，Tony，我是什麼？)
